Through BEST employment, The Australian Career Developments Studies were organized and funded by the Wimmera Southern Mallee LLEN and the LCP to offer up skilling qualifications to those working with young people in the region.

The three components that were completed to form the Career Development Studies are as follows:

Provide Careers Guidance – CHCCAR501A

Analyse and apply labour market information – CHCES401A

Utilise specialist communication skills to build strong relationships – CHCCOM3C
