What's in the pack?

- Actions that help you build knowledge, not just talk about it

How to use them

- Choose a few cards each week
- Take turns asking the questions
- Complete one action together
- Keep the conversation going

There are no right or wrong answers — the goal is to explore, not decide everything at once.
